

NLD STUDY ON C2 SERVICES FOR JIMP AND FLOWS

The NLD MOD has requested the national organisation for applied scientific research (TNO) to start a national study on C2 services for operations in a Joint, Interagency, Multinational and Public (JIMP) environment and “flows”. The term flows refers to the dynamic interaction between (activities of) actors and factors in an environment.

The study focuses on the future C2 support systems for situational awareness and decision making. This effort will be supported by all services with expertise in the meetings and representation in the steering board. This wide participation will ensure that the research/development is in line with future operations and meets demands. C2 developments within NATO and the EU are also important for the study, as the Netherlands has to stay aligned with them.

This study and its outcome have a close relationship with the work and tasking of the NATO C2COE. It provides an opportunity to cooperate closely with TNO, our special partner, and the services that work at the centre on the development of future C2.

The centre will provide an NLD C2 specialist to contribute to the conceptual chapters.
