- How the enemy is conducting actions in multi-domains?











Adversaries Multi-domain Operations – RADAR VIEW




Adversaries Multi-domain Operations – SEISMOGRAPH VIEW



Key Definitions



CCIR:

Information requirement identified by commanders as being critical to facilitating decision making, allowing to verify assumptions or protecting our own centers of gravity. Limited in number, they are developed during the design and planning process and change as the mission, priorities and operating environment changes.

TRIGGER:

Anything, as an act, event or situation, that serves as a stimulus and initiates or precipitates a reaction or series of reactions that may cause the emergence of a critical information.

CUE:

A weak signal, an element of information that can appear random or disconnected, or at first taken for a background noise, but which is recognized as important by linking it to other pieces of information.
